- Outreach & Strategic Plan Update\_- Luke Steere representing Deb: 9 goals, plan for concrete action steps eg. Advocacy: drafting a letter for librarians if their district budget comes up and library positions may be cut. Goals connected to action steps. Meeting again in June.
